



INTERN CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be enrolled in or recently graduated from a University or College.
- Commit to the full internship date period.
- Be able to financially support themselves (internships are unpaid, but lunches are included daily).
- Have strong swimming skills and physically able to work in in-water interactive programs.
- Be comfortable with public speaking.
- Be able to lift 50lbs

ACCEPTED APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be comfortable handling dead fish.
- Attend all required seminars and training courses.
- Commit a minimum of 40 hours per week (including nights and weekends).
- Submit to random drug tests.
- International Applicants must be able to obtain the correct Visa in time for the start of the program. Sea Life Park is NOT a sponsor. It is the responsibility of the applicant to find a sponsor.

- **COVE EXPERIENCE:** Interns will gain experience working with a wholphin, dolphins, Humboldt Penguins, and sea lions in show, exhibit, and interactive program capacities.
- **ALOHA EXPERIENCE:** Interns will gain experience working with dolphins in reproductive, show, and interactive program capacities.
- **HAWAIIAN EXPERIENCE:** Interns will gain experience working with dolphins, sea lions, Humboldt Penguins, and monk seals in show, exhibit, and interactive program capacities.
- **REEF EXPERIENCE:** Interns will gain experience working with green sea turtles, stingrays, sharks, and reef fish in exhibit and interactive program capacities.
- **WINGS EXPERIENCE:** Interns will gain experience working with a large variety of healthy and rehabilitating sea birds in exhibit and medical program capacities.
- **VETERINARY TECHNICIAN EXPERIENCE:** Applicants must have some previous veterinary technician experience. Interns will gain experience working directly with our veterinary staff to care for all animals housed within Sea Life Park Hawaii by assisting with lab procedures and record keeping. Animal interaction is limited.
