



INTERN CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be enrolled in a University or College.
- Commit to the full internship date period.
- Be able to financially support themselves (internships are non-paid, but lunches are included daily).
- Have strong swimming skills and physically able to work in in-water interactive programs.
- Be comfortable with public speaking.

ACCEPTED APPLICANTS MUST:

- Commit to the full internship date period.
- Attend all required seminars and training courses.
- Commit a minimum of 40 hours per week (including nights and weekends).
- Submit to random drug tests.
